PlantMaster Tip

If you have added plants to a project and then edit the data for any of those plants in that project, the updated information will **NOT** be shown in any of the reports. You must **delete** the plant from the project and then **add it again**. Then the new information will appear in the reports that use this edited information.

Are you adding jpgs of your landscape work to GardenWorks but find this time-consuming? Yes, it takes time but here's a tip that may help you:

After adding your photo, the landscape record will appear for you to mark which categories you wish to add your photo to. Mark your picture in **2** categories only, the first one (**put in a caption**, designer, photographer name and notes) and the last category (change one of the custom fields **to your company name**). You will be able to search for your picture easily if you have it marked as your company name. Later, you can edit the photo and add it to other landscape categories.

- ability to **export plant pictures** from a project to your hard drive;
